Thursday: **Arrild Ferieby**

1:4 000. Newly drawn 2019, virgin terrain. Summer cottage area with some woodland between the houses.

Friday: **Stensbæk Nord**

1:10:000, before 3 and 4 km difficult 7:500 - Updated 2019.

Forest with large areas of inland dunes and a good deal of brushwood dikes.

Saturday: **Brogård Plantage**

1:10:000, before 3 and 4 km difficult 7:500 -newly drawn, virgin terrain.

Mainly coniferous forest, slightly hilly in the eastern part. There is a good deal of brushwood dikes and other kinds of dikes, and a large gravel pit.

## SI cards

Rental SI cards are handed out at the start. The rental SI card must be returned after finishing on Saturday. In case of malfunctioning control: punch on your map.

Rental of an SI card costs DKK 15 in addition to the entry fee for each race. There is a no-return charge of DKK 500.

## Entry fees

M/W21+ Thursday DKK 100, Friday and Saturday DKK 100/day (200).
