Built-up area with parkland. Traffic laws must be obeyed. Please respect that private areas (olive green) are off limits, and do not cross hedges and

other items marked as impassable on the map. We need to leave a good impression with the locals.

Low chains blocking moped traffic may be passed.

**Saturday: Hytterkobbel Skov**

1:7500 freshly drawn in 2021 by Jens Peder Jensen. Fairly flat mixed forest. Fairly good runnability, many tracks. Some of the forest has not been cleared since the '99 hurricane.

**Sunday: Stursbøl Skov**

1:10000 and 1:7500 – freshly drawn 2023 by Keld Rasmussen. Fairly flat mixed forest. Fairly good runnability, many tracks.

**Timing and controls** We use Sport-Ident. **Non-finishers must go to the finish and have their SI card read. "Shadows" - do not cross the finish line.**

**SI-cards** Rental SI-cards are handed out at the start. The rental SI-card must be returned after finishing on Sunday. In case of malfunctioning control: punch on the control description on your map.

Rental of an SI-card costs DKK 15 in addition to the entry fee for each race. There is a no-return charge of DKK 500.

**Entry fees** M/W-20 Friday DKK 80, Saturday-Sunday DKK 80/day (160).  
M/W21+ Friday DKK 100, Saturday-Sunday DKK 100/day (200).  
**It is possible to do single days, but Saturday plus Sunday count for prizes and Viking challenge trophies!**

<b>Prizes</b>	On the Friday prizes to all class winners are given in the assembly area immediately after the competition. <b>Prize giving in the assembly area Sunday as soon as the winners have been found around 12.30.</b> <b>Prizes go to the top 3 places in junior classes (when more than 5 competitors), and winners in senior classes. The prizes are Viking blouses. Also prizes to other placings according to the "Vikingedyst" system: nos. 6 - 12 - 18 etc. Collect your placing prize in person, or the prize goes to the next competitor.</b> Furthermore, there are 2 challenge trophies · Senior classes: Hand-crafted Viking axe · Junior classes: Hand-crafted Viking sword. They go to the best club results (points) for Saturday and Sunday. The top 3 juniors and the top 4 seniors count. Another challenge trophy, a hand-crafted Viking helmet, goes to the club with most participants.
