SI-cards

Rental SI-cards are handed out at the start. The rental SI-card must be returned after finishing on Sunday. In case of malfunctioning control: punch on the control description on your map.

Rental of an SI-card costs DKK 40 in addition to the entry fee for each race. There is a no-return charge of DKK 500.
