How to get there

**Friday:** Signage on road no. 25 - in Løgumkloster roundabout. Assembly area: to be announced.

**Saturday:** signage from road no. 179 in roundabout south of Arnum. Assembly area and parking are inside the forest at Hundeskoven 55°11'30.8"N 8°57'47.7"E (55.191877, 8.963243)

**Sunday:** Signage on road 25 - just north of Jels village. Assembly area and parking at the south end of Haraldsholm, Lindbjergvej 3: 55°22'21.5"N 9°12'09.2"E (55.372641, 9.202545)

**Distances** Max 500 m from parking to start.
